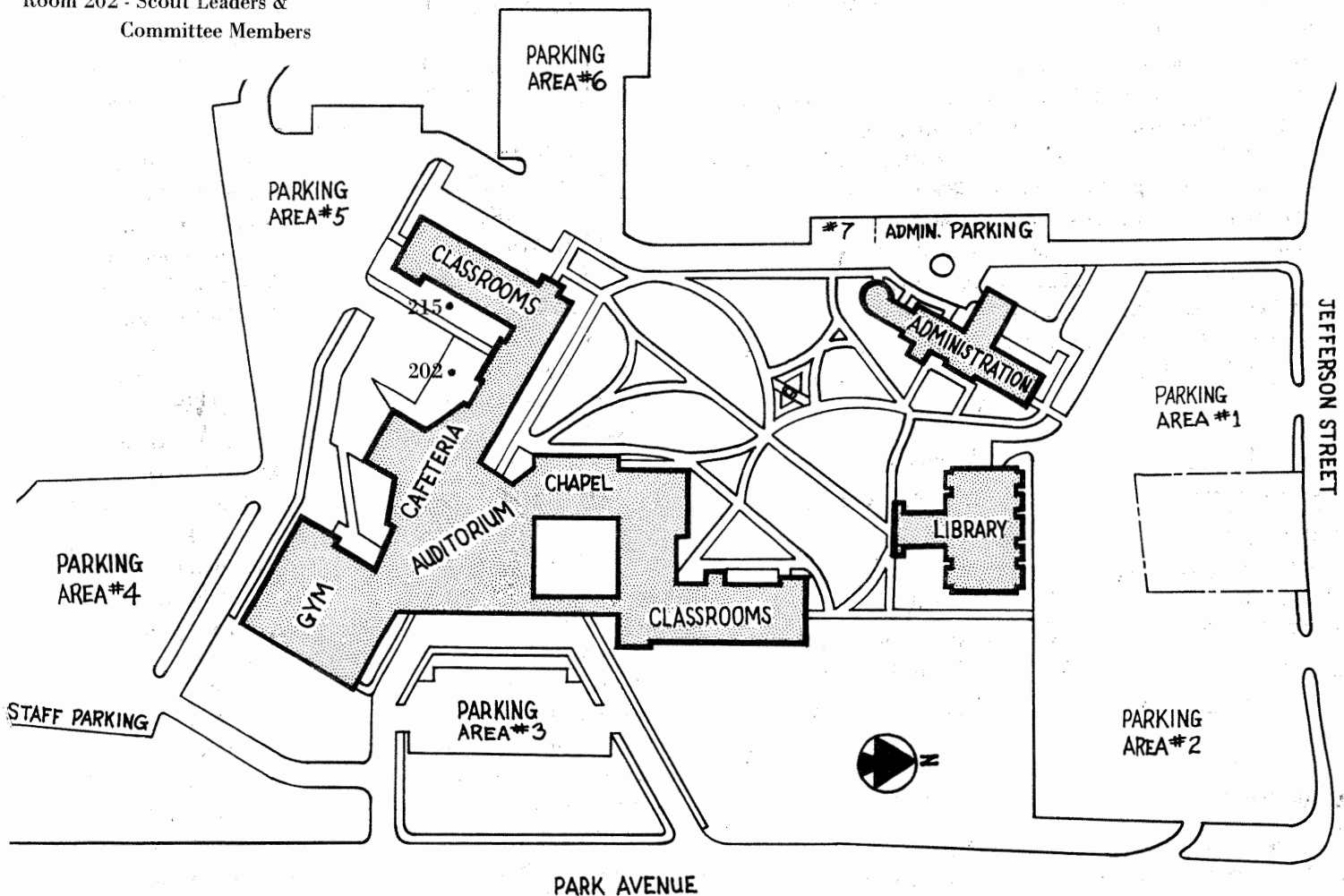
MEET THE NEW ROUNDTABLE STAFF

John has served our District well starting in July 1962 through March 1966 as Scoutmaster of Troop 81 Danbury. March 1966 through December 1968 Troop Committeeman of Troop 81 Danbury. January 1968 to June 1968 - Multiple Scoutmaster and Troop Committeeman of Troop 81 Danbury. January 1968 - June 1968 Assistant District Commissioner. January 1968 - July 1973 District Commissioner.

John received the Bronze Pelican, one of the highest Catholic awards bestowed by the Diocese of Bridgeport. John received the Hamilton Ogleman Award for the outstanding Scouter in the Scatacook District for the year 1970. John was well loved and respected by both the boys and adults. We shall miss him.

ROBUSTELLI HEADS BOROS SCOUT PRO-AM

Richard P. McGrath, Wilton, Chairman of the Foundations and Special Projects sub-committee of the Finance Committee of the Fairfield County Council, Boy Scouts of America announces the appointment of Andy Robustelli, Stamford, as Chairman of the 1973 Julius Boros Scout Pro-Am golf tournament. The tournament honoring Fairfield's own Julius Boros will be played Tuesday September 4th at the prestigious Golf Club at Aspetuck in Easton.

Serving with the former New York Giant Captain and Professional Football Hall of Famer are: George Cohen, Herb Brough and Jack Flaherty of Stamford, Robert Armstrong of Darien and James Knapp of Wilton.

Johnny Jacobs, veteran tour Professional is among the first signed-up of many tour professionals expected to participate. A permanent Julius Boros Scout Pro-Am trophy will be awarded the winning team of three amateurs and a tour or club P.G.A. Professional.

Chairman Robustelli is a native of Stamford where he attended public school graduating from High School in 1943. He attended La Salle Academy in Oakdale, Long Island during 1943 and 1944 and served in the United States Navy from 1944 to 1946. He received his B.S. Degree from Arnold College where during his undergraduate years he was named to the Little All American Football team three years, he also earned three varsity letters in baseball.

Robustelli was drafted by the Los Angeles Rams in 1951 and played for the Rams until 1956. During that time he was named Ram outstanding lineman three times. Andy was traded to the New York Giants in 1956 where during the next eight years he compiled the following record: played in 174 consecutive games, played in two College - Professional All Star games, played in 8 world championship games, played in 9 All Star Pro Bowl games, selected as outstanding NFL player in 1962 for which he received the Bert Bell award and was voted into Helms Football Foundation. He was elected into the Professional Football Hall of Fame in 1970.

His community service includes 1969-1970 Chairman of the Connecticut Tuberculosis Christmas Seal Campaign, 1972 Chairman of the Stamford United Fund, is a member of Stamford's Old Age Commission and is a member of the President's Council on Physical Fitness and Sports. Robustelli is President of Robustelli Travel Service Inc.

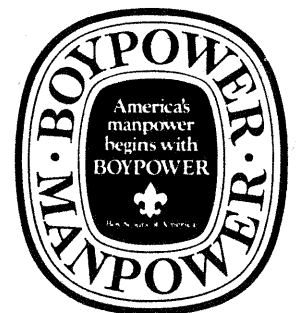
